



Registration

- For K4, the child must be 4 years of age on or before Spetember 30th.
- For Kindergarten, the child must be 5 years of age on or before September 30th.
- For Grade 1, the child must be 6 years of age on or before September 30th.

The following documents will be required:

- Child's Original Long Form Birth Certificate (contains parents' names)
- ➤ Proof for English Eligibility → Parents Education in English, in Canada (Certificate of Eligibility for Parent OR High School marks from the Government)
- > Parent's Birth Certificate or Passport or Canadian Citizenship
- > Proof of Residency (Driver's licence, Tax bill etc.)
- > Child's Medicare Card
- > Copy of your child's vaccination booklet
